

EYTS to QTS

At Bromley Schools' Collegiate, we have developed a conversion course for holders of Early Years Teacher Status (EYTS) so they can gain Qualified Teacher Status. This would then enable you to become an Early Years professional, covering the 0 to 7 year old age range with both EYTS and QTS.

The entry requirements for this programme are:

- A UK Honours degree or equivalent
- GCSE grade A*- C in English, Mathematics and Science
- Passes in both Professional Skills tests
- Hold EYTS

Phase 1 of the programme (11 weeks training phase)

This training will provide additional training to bridge the gaps between the EYTS standards and QTS. Delivered by trainers from our Outstanding Primary ITT programme. During this phase you will either need to be employed within year R to 2 or we will arrange for 2 days per week of work experience in a local school.

Phase 2 of the programme (3 Calendar Months Assessment Only phase)

This will involve developing a portfolio of evidence and being observed undertaking whole class teaching by an external assessor. *This is for those who have been working in a full time teaching post for a minimum of one year with two years minimum teaching experience overall.*
