

Final Check List Before Sending Your UCAS Form

UCAS Points

- 1 Remember - the number of UCAS points you have are calculated on your **BEST THREE A-Levels**, not *all* your A-Levels (imagine: some people could do six A-Levels, they would clearly have far more points than someone doing three).
- 2 Double-check your UCAS entry points before making your final choices e.g. if the university is asking for 320 points, this is likely to be in three A-Levels only, and the text might say that 300 points have to be in certain subjects. You **MUST** match these subjects or you will be rejected.

Final Check List Before Making Your Final Choices

Insurance Offers - probably done from January of Year 13 onwards:

Please make sure you have an insurance offer which is well below what you think you will achieve i.e. if you think you will get three Cs at A2, ensure one of your offers is for, say, DDE.
